Blooket



Blooket is a student response activity that encourages students to compete with classmates while reviewing information, learning new skills, or just for fun!

Here's how it works:

- The teacher selects a question set (or creates their own) and a game mode of their choosing.
- The game creates a code that students enter on their device.
- Students will answer questions to win and compete with other students, whether individually or on a team.

Blooket also integrates with Quizlet. What sets Blooket apart is that the quizzes can be re-themed using a variety of "game modes" that offer unique visual themes and game play types, making them similar to games students might play on their personal devices for fun.

These embedded games have their own visual themes and rules. For instance, in the Racing mode, students might answer five questions and then watch as their avatars face off in a race determined by how well they did on the quizzes. In addition to the Racing mode there are other modes to try out and enjoy. Games can be played solo or in teams, and, depending on the game mode, they can be assigned as homework.
