

- 2 adults/student may come watch the parade and join our parties.
- Costumes worn by students must not contain blood or weapons.
- Costumes should be worn to school.
- Parade/party visitors must sign-in OUTSIDE where the SW corner of the playground meets Broadway St., starting at 9:30 and ending at 9:55.
 (Parade will begin shortly after)
- All visitors will receive a visitor tag upon sign-in. This tag must be worn to watch the parade and for entrance into the building for parties. The main Office Entrance/Door A-1 will be the only entrance into the building for parties. Visitors should report there after the parade.
- Please do not go to other classrooms to visit other children.
- All parties must end BY 11:10.
- Parents/guardians who wish to take their children home from the parties will need to sign them out in the classroom before leaving. A note from a parent/guardian must be sent in before a student can be signed out by anyone other than the parent/guardian. (This includes grandparents or other family members who will be taking students home. They will not be able to do so without notes from parents/guardians.)
