

Senior Decision Recognition

Many Missouri high schools celebrate their seniors' plans for the future. At CJHS, we would like to recognize our seniors as they are ready, and with their permission. Some seniors may choose to enter an apprenticeship or work-based learning program, go to trade or technical school, attend a community college or university, enter the military, or obtain employment. Some students are not ready to make this decision yet; therefore, this is an ongoing recognition program that is voluntary and can happen when students are ready.

Seniors who would like to participate will be recognized in the form of a picture of the senior, along with a brief statement of his or her plans to be temporarily displayed on a slide show in the CJHS entry way in May, prior to the graduation ceremony.
