Senior Decision Recognition

Many Missouri high schools are celebrating their seniors' plans for the future. At CJHS, we would like to recognize our seniors as they are ready and with the permission of their families. Some seniors may choose to enter an apprenticeship or work-based learning program, go to trade or technical school, attend a community college or university, enter the military, or obtain employment. Some students are not ready to make this decision yet; therefore, this is an ongoing recognition program that is voluntary and can happen when students are ready.

Seniors who would like to participate have the option to be recognized in two different ways. They may choose one or both. Verbal recognition will be in the form of a morning announcement, and visual recognition will be in the form of a picture of the senior (submitted by the student) along with a brief statement of his or her plans to be temporarily displayed in a glass case in the CJHS entry way.

All recognition requests will be submitted by hard copy to Mrs. Kristy Jones, postsecondary advisor, and each photo/statement will go through the approval process before being displayed.
