The Carl Junction Area Chamber of Commerce (CJACC) awards two \$500 scholarships annually to graduating Carl Junction High School seniors. The one-time award is paid directly to each student to be applied to future educational expenses. Selection criteria include academic performance, involvement in activities, school and community service, leadership, and future educational and career goals. The scholarship is open to any student pursuing post-secondary education, including trade or technical training, junior college, or a four-year degree. Preference will be given to students affiliated with the CJACC if multiple students are deemed to be deserving of the award.
