FREE, ALL-INCLUSIVE PROGRAM

Four Star Leadership is a world-class summer leadership program that accepts 70 top high school students each year. The program provides experiences and interaction with inspirational leaders as well as a scholarship competition. This opportunity is valued at more than \$4,000 and is free of cost for selected students, including expenses, travel and programming. Four Star Leadership 2023 will be held July 9-14 in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. The deadline for applications is May 3.

FOUR STAR LEADERSHIP IS UNIQUE

Students will be challenged with practical leadership and ethical scenarios and then asked to address them individually in a persuasive speech and writing competition as well as collaboratively in an ethics bowl competition.

The program includes team-building exercises, spontaneous problem solving and coaching in persuasive speaking and writing. The program is FREE to students.

PREPARING STUDENTS FOR THE FUTURE

Students have an opportunity to earn scholarships, gain internships and invaluable leadership experience. Students who attend Four Star Leadership with General Tommy Franks will have a distinct advantage entering college and in their early career. Many former attendees have also received letters of recommendation.

Since 2008, Four Star Leadership has welcomed more than 841 U.S. high school students from 46 different states as well as 57 international students. Working with a range of leaders, including dignitaries, politicians and star athletes, students have explored critical national and international ethical issues such as education reform, foreign policy and entitlement spending.

Students will visit several halls of leadership including the General Tommy Franks Leadership Institute and Museum, the Oklahoma State Capitol, the Governor's Mansion, The Oklahoma City National Memorial & Museum and more.

Four Star Leadership is an in-person experience. However, shall the pandemic affect public health and travel, the program will be hosted virtually.

Rooms, meals and transportation are provided at no cost to the participants. Rooms are provided by Oklahoma Christian University and meals are provided and furnished by the generosity of our sponsors. Students will be supervised and cared for by trained, professional adults 24 hours a day.

TOMMY FRANKS was born in Wynnewood, Oklahoma, and grew up in Midland, Texas.

He joined the United States Army, and in 1967, as a distinguished graduate of the Artillery Officer Candidate School, he was commissioned a Second Lieutenant and sent to Vietnam.

In June 2000, he was promoted to Four Star General and assigned as Commander-in-Chief, United States Central Command. It's in this

career that saw him lead
American and coalition
troops in two strategically

campaigns in two

years – Operation Enduring Freedom in Afghanistan and Operation Iraqi Freedom in Iraq.

The General's awards include five Distinguished Service Medals, four Legions of Merit, four Bronze Stars and three Purple Hearts in addition to numerous foreign awards. He was knighted by Queen Elizabeth and President George W. Bush awarded him with the Presidential Medal of Freedom.

"I can think of no better way to instill the important traits of character, common vision, communication and caring than to attend the FREE Four Star Leadership program," said General Tommy Franks. "Four Star Leadership is my way of sharing these traits directly with young men and women from around the world that are upcoming leaders. There is no greater call to answer than that of leadership, service and patriotism. This is the first step for these future leaders to take toward their life-long service to others."
