### **Jasper County Beef Producers**

#### **Scholarship Guidelines**

- 1. Applicant must be a Missouri resident of Jasper County and a member of the Missouri (Junior) Cattlemen's Association (\$10 Fee).
- 2. Applicant must submit two (2) letters of recommendation.
- 3. Applicant must attach a proof of enrollment in or acceptance to the college/university/technical school you plan to/do attend.
- 4. Applicant must be a high school senior or a full-time college/technical school student and have a GPA of 2.5 out of a 4.0 scale or higher. Applicant must have been a full-time student (high school or college/technical school) the previous year and not have reached their 23<sup>rd</sup> birthday by January 1 of the next year. Applicant must attend an accredited college, university or technical school to collect scholarship.
- 5. Applicant must submit the most recent available, high school or college transcript to Jasper County Beef Producers for proof of grade point average and enrollment. Transcript should be included with the application.
- 6. Applicant must demonstrate leadership potential through extracurricular activities and work experiences.
- 7. Preference may be given to students who plan to/are attending Missouri colleges, universities or technical schools.
- 8. Applications must be returned to Jasper County Beef Producers and be postmarked by May 15<sup>th</sup> of current year.
- 9. Jasper County Beef Producers Scholarship Committee will review applications and all applicants will be notified regarding the committee's decision by June 30<sup>th</sup> of current year.
- 10. A minimum of 2 scholarships of \$500 will be payable no later than September 1<sup>st</sup> of current year. Funds for scholarships will be sent directly to the recipients.
- 11. Application Packet **MUST** include:
  - a. Completed and signed application
  - b. Two letters of recommendation
  - c. Proof of enrollment in or acceptance to the college/university/technical school you plan/do attend
  - d. Current school transcript (entering college/technical school freshmen submit high school transcript)
  - e. Essay describing how your plans and goals for your future could have a positive impact on the beef industry
