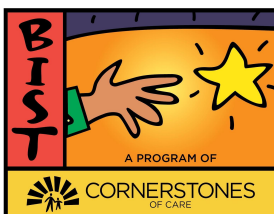

    4. **Enter your information (Name, Email, and a Password). This will register you on the website, but not for the class.**

5. Select the class you wish to attend. Click **Register** to the right of the class name.
  6. Follow the instructions.
    - a. Be sure to select **Pay Later via PO** under the Payment Method. This Parent Class is free, but you must select the Pay Later via PO option in order to register.
    - b. Select your child's District and School from the dropdown menus.
    - c. Select your position as a **Parent** unless you are a school staff member. If you are both a parent and a school staff member, you may select either.
- Once you have registered, you will receive a confirmation email containing the zoom link for the training sessions.
