

**CARL JUNCTION JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL SUMMER SCHOOL INFORMATION**  
*(intended for incoming 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> graders and some current year 8<sup>th</sup> graders\*)*

1. Summer school will be June 3-June 28 at CJJH, from 8:00-11:00 a.m., lunch, then from 11:30-2:30 p.m.
2. Lunch will be served from 11:00 to 11:30 – full price lunch is \$2.55; reduced lunch price is \$.40.
3. Students are allowed only two absences per session. A session is either a morning or afternoon class. Upon the 3<sup>rd</sup> absence per session, the student will be removed from the class and credit cannot be given. 3 tardies = 1 absence.
4. Summer school courses are PASS/FAIL credit.
5. We will have bus service for summer school. Look for information regarding routes and stops soon.
6. A final grade report will be sent home upon completion of the course.

**\*Back to Basics: open to incoming 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders and incoming 9<sup>th</sup> graders upon request**

\_\_\_\_\_ **Back to Basics:** course runs from 8:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Grade is PASS/FAIL. This course is designed for students who struggled with their math and/or English courses during the previous school year. The course is intended to help support and build upon the basic concepts all JH students should be able to master at this level. Students will engage in either mathematics in the morning and English in the afternoon or reverse.

*This course is both an A.M. and a P.M. course and cannot be taken along with another course.*

**Physical Education/Health: open to incoming 7<sup>th</sup> and incoming 8<sup>th</sup> graders**

\_\_\_\_\_ **A.M. Physical Education/Health:** course runs from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. Grade is PASS/FAIL. Successful completion of the 4 week session = 1 semester junior high PE credit.

\_\_\_\_\_ **P.M. Physical Education/Health:** course runs from 11:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Grade is PASS/FAIL. Successful completion of the 4 week session = 1 semester junior high PE credit.

*Students may choose either AM or PM physical education. Students may not choose both.*

**Social Studies Elective History Through STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math): open to incoming 7<sup>th</sup> and incoming 8<sup>th</sup> graders**

Students will study inventions and how they changed the way people lived throughout American history. Students will work to recreate and build historical inventions as part of a STEM lab experience.

\_\_\_\_\_ **A.M. History Through STEM:** course runs from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. Grade is PASS/FAIL. Class is an elective and does not replace any regular session JH course.

\_\_\_\_\_ **P.M. History Through STEM:** course runs from 11:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Grade is PASS/FAIL. Class is an elective and does not replace any regular session JH course.

*Students may choose either AM or PM History Through STEM. Students may not choose both.*

**Instrumental Music Elective Summer Band: open to incoming 7<sup>th</sup> and incoming 8<sup>th</sup> graders**

This elective class is intended for incoming 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students who will be enrolled in band during the regular school year. Students will focus on fundamentals, expanding technical ability, and playing range. Students will play from current curricular materials in addition to full band music provided by the instructor and learning how to compose music for solo and small ensemble.

\_\_\_\_\_ **A.M. Summer Band Elective:** course runs from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. Grade is PASS/FAIL. Class is an elective and does not replace any regular session JH course.

\_\_\_\_\_ **P.M. Summer Band Elective:** course runs from 11:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Grade is PASS/FAIL. Class is an elective and does not replace any regular session JH course.

*Students may choose either AM or PM Summer Band Elective. Students may not choose both.*

**Art Elective Summer Of Color: open to incoming 7<sup>th</sup> and incoming 8<sup>th</sup> graders**

Students will engage in printmaking, clay, photography and other hands-on activities. In this fun elective, students will grow a deeper understanding with each of these activities and create memorable projects.

\_\_\_\_\_ **A.M. Summer Art Elective:** course runs from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. Grade is PASS/FAIL. Class is an elective and does not replace any regular session JH course.

\_\_\_\_\_ **P.M. Summer Art Elective:** course runs from 11:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Grade is PASS/FAIL. Class is an elective and does not replace any regular session JH course.

*Students may choose either AM or PM Summer Art Elective. Students may not choose both.*

**Social Studies Elective History Through Theater: open to incoming 7<sup>th</sup> and incoming 8<sup>th</sup> graders**

By studying primary resources and documents, along with modern day techniques of historical interpretation (stage acting, roleplaying, etc), students will together craft and perform scenes/sequences from throughout American History.

\_\_\_\_\_ **A.M. Summer Social Studies Elective:** course runs from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. Grade is PASS/FAIL. Class is an elective and does not replace any regular session JH course.

\_\_\_\_\_ **P.M. Summer Social Studies Elective:** course runs from 11:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Grade is PASS/FAIL. Class is an elective and does not replace any regular session JH course.

*Students may choose either AM or PM Summer Social Studies Elective. Students may not choose both.*

**Online Digital Computer Applications: open to incoming 8<sup>th</sup> graders only**

This is the online version of our regular 8<sup>th</sup> grade semester course. Space is limited. Students must have access to a desk-top or lap-top with Internet access and the Microsoft Office suite at home. The course is designed to introduce students to the features of word processing, spreadsheets and formatting of business documents by using various software packages, focusing on Microsoft Office. Proofreading is stressed and emphasis is placed on using the computer as a tool to use in everyday living.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Online Digital Computer Applications:** course runs from June 3 through June 28. Grade is PASS/FAIL. Successful completion of the 4 week session = 1 semester 8<sup>th</sup> grade Digital Computer Applications credit. This is an at-home, online course.

*Space is limited. Priority will be granted to those entering the 8<sup>th</sup> grade with specific scheduling constraints. All other enrollment requests will be first-come, first-serve until the class is full. Call Mr. Sawyer at the Junior High with questions.*
