1. Summer school will run June 3 - June 28 from 8:00 - 11:00 a.m. and then from 11:30 - 2:30 p.m.
2. Lunch is from 11:00 – 11:30. Full price lunch is \$2.55 and reduced lunch price is \$0.40.
3. Students may have two absences per session. A student may be removed from class after three absences.
4. Three tardies count as one absence.
6. Students may be removed from summer school upon the first discipline referral.
7. Summer school courses are not calculated in the GPA.
8. Driver Education will be offered for students, including incoming freshmen, 15 years old by June 3.
9. Incoming freshmen may take Physical Education. PE is open to students in grades 9 – 12.
10. Students will be enrolled in credit recovery for the full day unless also enrolled in P.E.

**Credit Recovery** is a program that allows current CJHS students to earn credits for classes which they have failed and/or received no credit. Students who have dropped out of school may earn credits toward graduation. Credit is earned by completing the assigned online curriculum. The students work independently and at their own pace. All classes are graded pass/fail and are worth one-half credit each.

**I have read the Summer School information and agree to the following terms:**

- I understand that upon completion of all courses, I will receive ½ credit for each class. A minimum of 30 attendance hours are required.
- To ensure accountability, I understand that students may work on the assignments at home, but mastery tests, post-tests, and end-of-semester tests must be taken at CJHS.
- I understand that any test completed off-site will not be counted toward completion of the course, and that no credit will be issued.
- I understand that I may be removed from summer school upon my third absence.
- I understand that I may be removed from summer school upon my first discipline referral.
- Bus transportation will be provided (modified routes).
- I understand that once ALL courses on my list are completed, I no longer need to attend summer school.

## Carl Junction High School Summer 2019 Launch Online Enrollment

Carl Junction High School will offer traditional online courses via Launch virtual academy during summer school. Launch courses give students an opportunity to personalize their educational experience during their high school years. Students in grades 9-12, who meet dual credit course requirements, are able to enroll in a Launch course. See the CJHS planning guide for additional dual credit information.

- Courses are offered in two separate month-long sessions – June OR July – and must be completed during the enrolled session. Courses may not extend over both sessions.
- Students wishing to take a full (1.0) credit course must meet with their counselor prior to enrollment due to course rigor.
- Students will earn one-half (0.5) or one (1) credit upon successful completion of a course.
- A letter grade will be given but will not be calculated in the GPA.
- June courses may be taken at home or school, and CJHS tech support will be available.
- July courses must be taken off-site, and CJHS tech support is not provided.
- Launch tech support will be available 7 days a week through [support@fueledbylaunch.com](mailto:support@fueledbylaunch.com).

- Each Launch course requires students to take a proctored final exam.
- Students may drop a Launch summer course within 2 days of enrollment.

## Summer School 2019

### DRIVER EDUCATION

- Students must be 15 by the first day of summer school.
- Students will receive a Pass/Fail grade and earn no credit toward graduation.
- Class size is limited and enrollment is on a first come, first served basis. Students not enrolled in or in need of credit recovery are given preference.

The course is divided into two sessions:

1. Classroom session runs June 3 – 14.
2. Driving and observation is scheduled with instructors the first few days of the session.

**Students must pass both sessions to pass the class.**

### Classroom

- Students will have **30 hours of classroom instruction** from June 3 – 14.
- One class absence is allowed and students are required to make up the time on June 17.
- A student will be dropped from the class upon the second absence. There are no exceptions for camps, sickness, doctor's appointments, etc.
- Two tardies count as one absence since this is only a two-week classroom session.

### Driving and observation

- Six (6) hours driving and twelve (12) hours of observation are required.
- Instructors will develop the schedule the first few days of class.
- Driving takes approximately 6 weeks to complete depending on the schedule, but occasionally a student may finish sooner.
- Students are expected to attend all scheduled driving sessions. If there is a conflict, let the instructor know as soon as possible. If a student has an unexcused absence from driving time, they may be dropped from the course.
- If a student has started driving before class time is complete and they fail the classroom portion, they may not continue driving.

Responsible student behavior is expected in the driving vehicle whether driving or observing.

Cell phones, electronic devices, magazines, etc. are not allowed while in the vehicle. Students' personal belongings will be stored in the trunk of the vehicle. Students should also be well-prepared to drive.

Sandals, flip flops, etc. are not acceptable footwear for Driver Education. Hairstyles should be such that no hair is hanging in front of the eyes, blocking the vision of the student driver.

Driver Education is offered to Carl Junction students first. The CJHS registrar will keep a list of Carl Junction students and out-of-district students who have requested to be placed on the waiting list. If there are any openings (no shows), these students will be contacted on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of summer school.
