Date: Friday, September 30, 2022

Times: 11:45 A.M. – May begin lining up floats

Please line up at your designated area. We will be spray painting numbers on the road to designate parade lineup.

Please have your float lined up and ready by 12:15 P.M.

Judging begins at 12:30 P.M.

Parade begins at 1:15 P.M. and will end at approximately 1:50 P.M.

Line-Up Locations: Will be distributed by email on Wednesday, September 28th

Unloading: You must take your float back to the Jr. High or High School, or unload in the grass area on the corner of Verbruyck and Wise. Please do not unload on the roads, but rather find an area out of the way of after school traffic. Please help keep the parade going and get the fire trucks back to the fire station as fast as possible. Just a reminder: K-6 students must be taken back to their schools by the club/sport sponsor.

Candy: Please make sure any candy being thrown during the parade is thrown far enough to the sides of the street so kids will not be tempted to run out into the road. Otherwise, people can walk along the sides of the road and hand the candy out. Do NOT throw out ANYTHING besides candy. Remember if we cannot throw candy correctly we will lose this privilege in future parades.

Sign-Ups: You must sign-up to enter the parade. There was a sign-up link included in the Homecoming 2022 email. If you are unable to fill out this form, please email gbroce@cjr1.org or trutledge@cjr1.org with the following information: Group name, Coach/Sponsor Name, email and phone number. Please sign up by Monday, September 26th. Please note if you sign-up past this date, you **CAN STILL** be in the parade, but will be in at the very back **regardless**. There is no entry fee. We will also not be able to guarantee certain spots for your float in the parade lineup.

Permission Forms and Float Rosters: All students in grades K-6 that are in the parade will need to sign a permission form and turn in to their classroom teachers. In

addition, please send a list of students that will be on your float to the appropriate school.

Please note, students from the Intermediate School (grades 4-6) who participate in the parade will not be allowed to return into the building at the end of the day. Sponsors who check out students from the Intermediate building will be responsible for returning students to the pick up area at the Intermediate School and supervising them until their parents/guardians arrive or students are dismissed to busses.

Jr. High and High School students in school activities will need a roster sent to their building secretaries by the director of the group. In addition, please send a list of students that will be on your float to the appropriate school. Release times for Jr. High/High School students in the parade will be sent out at a later time.
