1. Summer school will be June 1-June28. At CJJH, classes run from 8:00-11:00 a.m., lunch, then from 11:30-2:30 p.m.

Lunch is served from 11:00 to 11:30 a.m. Students who qualify for free/reduced meals also qualify during summer school.
Students are allowed only two absences per session. A session is either a morning or afternoon class. Upon the 3<sup>rd</sup> absence per session, the student will be removed from the class and credit equation be given. 3 tardies = 1 absence

absence per session, the student will be removed from the class and credit cannot be given. 3 tardies = 1 absence. 4. Summer school courses are PASS/FAIL credit.

## Summer Math and English: open to incoming 7th and 8th graders and some Freshmen

**\_\_\_\_\_Summer Math and English:** course runs from 8:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Grade is PASS/FAIL. This course is designed for students who struggled with math and English courses during the preceding regular Spring semester. The course is intended to help support and build upon the basic concepts all JH students should be able to master at this level. Students will engage in either mathematics in the morning and English in the afternoon or reverse. Class is an elective and does not replace any regular session JH course.

This course is both an A.M. and a P.M. course and <u>cannot</u> be taken along with another course.

## <u>Physical Education/Health:</u> open to incoming 7<sup>th</sup> and incoming 8<sup>th</sup> graders

**A.M. Physical Education/Health:** course runs from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. Grade is PASS/FAIL. Successful completion of the 4 week session = 1 semester junior high PE credit.

**P.M. Physical Education/Health:** course runs from 11:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Grade is PASS/FAIL. Successful completion of the 4 week session = 1 semester junior high PE credit.

Students may choose either AM or PM physical education. Students may not choose both. Summer athletic camps, church camps, and similar will not be substituted for PE credit.

Social Studies Elective <u>History Through STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math):</u> open to incoming 7<sup>th</sup> and incoming 8<sup>th</sup> graders

Students will study technological advancements throughout history and how they changed the way people lived. Students will work to recreate and build historical inventions as part of a STEM lab experience using 3D printers, mini-motors, and other resources.

**\_\_\_\_\_A.M. History Through STEM:** course runs from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. Grade is PASS/FAIL. Class is an elective and does not replace any regular session JH course.

**P.M. History Through STEM:** course runs from 11:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Grade is PASS/FAIL. Class is an elective and does not replace any regular session JH course.

Students may choose either AM or PM History Through STEM. Students may not choose both.

#### FACS Elective Cooking: Culinary 101: open to incoming 7th and incoming 8th graders

Students will engage in cooking and learning about different career opportunities, techniques, and skills involved in the cooking industry. Students will learn important skills for their own kitchens at home, as well!

**A.M. FACS Elective:** course runs from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. Grade is PASS/FAIL. Class is an elective and does not replace any regular session JH course.

**P.M. FACS Elective:** course runs from 11:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Grade is PASS/FAIL. Class is an elective and does not replace any regular session JH course.

Students may choose either AM or PM FACS Elective. Students may not choose both.

#### Art Elective Summer of Color: open to incoming 7th and incoming 8th graders

Students will engage in several creative art activities. Printmaking, clay, paint, and other media will be used to create projects like tiedye t-shirts, small cups and bowls from clay, paintings and more!

**\_\_\_\_\_A.M. Art Elective:** course runs from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. Grade is PASS/FAIL. Class is an elective and does not replace any regular session JH course.

**P.M. Art Elective:** course runs from 11:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Grade is PASS/FAIL. Class is an elective and does not replace any regular session JH course.

Students may choose either AM or PM Art Elective. Students may not choose both.

#### Elective <u>Outdoor Pursuits:</u> open to incoming 7<sup>th</sup> and incoming 8<sup>th</sup> graders

Students will participate in activities that promotes physical well-being, respect for nature and the environment, and opportunities to learn life-long skills. Activities include archery, geocaching and compass skills, knot tying and uses, plant identification, and basic first aid and survival skills!
