# CARL JUNCTION JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL SUMMER SCHOOL INFORMATION intended for incoming 7th & 8th graders

- 1. Summer school will be June 2-June27. At CJJH, classes run from 8:00-11:00 a.m., lunch, then from 11:30-2:30 p.m.
- 2. Lunch is served from 11:00 to 11:30 a.m. Students who qualify for free/reduced meals also qualify during summer school.
- 3. Students are allowed only two absences per session. A session is either a morning or afternoon class. Upon the  $3^{rd}$  absence per session, the student will be removed from the class and credit cannot be given. 3 tardies = 1 absence.
- 4. Summer school courses are PASS/FAIL credit.
- 5. We offer limited and altered bus service for summer school. Routes, bus numbers, bus stops, and times are different for summer school. Contact our transportation office at 417-649-5740 for details.
- 6. A final grade report will be sent home upon completion of the course.

Ī	Summer Math and English: open to incoming 7th and 8th graders and some Freshmen		
	Summer Math and English: course runs from 8:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Grade is PASS/FAIL. This course is designed for students who struggled with math and English courses during the preceding regular Spring semester. The course is intended to help support and build upon the basic concepts all JH students should be able to master at this level. Students will engage in either mathematics in the morning and English in the afternoon or reverse. Class is an elective and does not replace any regular session JH course.		
	This course is both an A.M. and a P.M. course and <u>cannot</u> be taken along with another course.		
Ī	Physical Education/Health: open to incoming 7 <sup>th</sup> and incoming 8 <sup>th</sup> graders		
	A.M. Physical Education/Health: course runs from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. Grade is PASS/FAIL. Successful completion of the 4 week session = 1 semester junior high PE credit.		
	P.M. Physical Education/Health: course runs from 11:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Grade is PASS/FAIL. Successful completion of the 4 week session = 1 semester junior high PE credit.		
	Students may choose either AM <u>or</u> PM physical education. Students may <u>not</u> choose both. Summer athletic camps, church camps, and similar will <u>not</u> be substituted for PE credit.		
Ī	English Elective <u>Lights! Camera! Action!</u> : open to incoming 7 <sup>th</sup> and incoming 8 <sup>th</sup> graders		
	Students will engage a hands-on approach to learning about photography and video production. Students will learn the secrets behind making stunning photos and video productions that help them tell a compelling and creative story.

# Social Studies Elective STEM History Projects (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math): open to incoming $7^{th}$ and incoming $8^{th}$ graders

Students will study technological advancements throughout history and how they changed the way people lived. Students will work to recreate and build historical inventions as part of a STEM lab experience using 3D printers, mini-motors, and other resources.

**P.M. History Through STEM:** course runs from 11:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Grade is PASS/FAIL. Class is an elective and does not replace any regular session JH course.

Students may choose either AM or PM Social Studies Elective. Students may not choose both.

### FACS Elective Cooking Basics: open to incoming 7th and incoming 8th graders

Students will learn the fundamentals of cooking including food safety and skills to stay safe in the kitchen. Students will learn about nutrition and will incorporate cooking techniques in making actual food dishes.

**\_\_\_\_\_A.M. FACS Elective:** course runs from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. Grade is PASS/FAIL. Class is an elective and does not replace any regular session JH course.

Students may choose either AM or PM FACS Elective. Students may not choose both.

## Art Elective Summer of Color: open to incoming 7th and incoming 8th graders

Students will engage in several creative activity including printmaking, working with clay, painting, and working with fiber. Students will create several projects in this fun summer elective.

#### Social Studies Elective Empires and Epic Myth: open to incoming 7<sup>th</sup> and incoming 8<sup>th</sup> graders

Students will study ancient civilizations and participate in creating their own empire in which they will craft a government, lead their citizens, and trade with other civilizations.
