Line-Up Locations: Will be distributed by Wednesday, September 25

**Unloading**: You are NOT allowed to unload students on Wise street. You must take your float back to the school (Jr. High or High School) or unload on Verbryck or Broadway. Please help keep the parade going and get the fire trucks back to the fire station as fast as possible.

**Candy**: Please make sure any candy being thrown during the parade is thrown far enough to the sides of the street so kids will not be tempted to run out into the road. Otherwise, people can walk along the sides of the road and hand the candy out. Do NOT throw out ANYTHING besides candy. Remember if we cannot throw candy correctly we will lose this privilege in future parades.
