

Primary 2-3 COVID Procedures

Hygiene

- See District Operating Procedures

Medical Inquiries

- See District Operating Procedures
- Teachers will be given first-aid kits for their classrooms. Teachers will be given direction on when to send students to the nurse.
- Teachers will call the office to be sure the nurse is available before sending students.

Physical Distancing

- Classroom desks will be arranged to all forward facing, with space between, when and where possible.
- Possible use of lap desk/trays for students to use in rotation for classes with tables.
- Tables will have students seated at diagonal and not face to face.
- Students will receive a set of center/manipulatives for the week in their own personal tubs.
- Students will rotate coming to the carpet for instruction and/or distanced.
- Students will distance at reading tables. Teachers will be encouraged to wear masks when close to students.
- Students in hallways will be monitored.

Transportation

- Busing- See District Operating Procedures
- Masks will be worn to parent pickup and social distancing will be followed.

Food Service

- Meals will be served in disposable containers.
- Students will eat in classrooms for breakfast.
- Students will rotate between classroom and cafeteria for lunch. (appropriate sanitizing)
- Water fountains will be used as a bottle filling station only.
- Healthy, pre-packaged snacks may be brought in accordance with the teacher's schedule or procedures.

Specials

- Specials will be held in the regular classroom and or specials' classroom (as appropriate).
 - Outside as much as possible.
 - Specials teachers will use carts to transport materials from class to class.

Open House

- 1 parent will attend with child.
- 30 minute scheduled visits.

Drills

- Individual classes will walk through drills together.
 - Teachers will report drill completion times to administration.
 - One report will be sent to CO.

Recess

- Rotate between equipment as a class group.

First Day of School

- Students will come to school via their typical mode of transportation.
- Parents will not walk students to their classrooms.

Title 1/Special Education Instruction

- Students will work with teachers in small cohort groups.
- Instruction will take place in Title 1/Special Education classrooms or through push-in service when applicable.
- Cleaning of materials and tabletops will need to be done between groups.
- Parents will need to be notified, by Title 1/Special Education teachers, that instruction will take place in a room where various students are instructed throughout the day, with safety/cleaning precautions in place.

PBS

- Will function as closely to normal as possible, with cleaning/safety precautions in place.
