(It is encouraged to type all responses on a separate page.)
3. **Visit** – Complete a tour at the academy. *Call 417-673-8828 today!*
4. **Submit** - Submit two character reference letters. *(teacher, employer, pastor, close family friend, etc)*
5. **Send it** – Submit high school transcripts through the first semester of your senior year. *(Transcripts must include attendance records.)*

The scholarship committee reviews each individual applicant and determines the award recipients. If your high school allows it, a staff member from CPBA will present the scholarship at your school's awards assembly. **All steps must be completed by the March 31, 2026 deadline in order to qualify. Early senior graduates must complete all steps by November 30th, 2025.**
